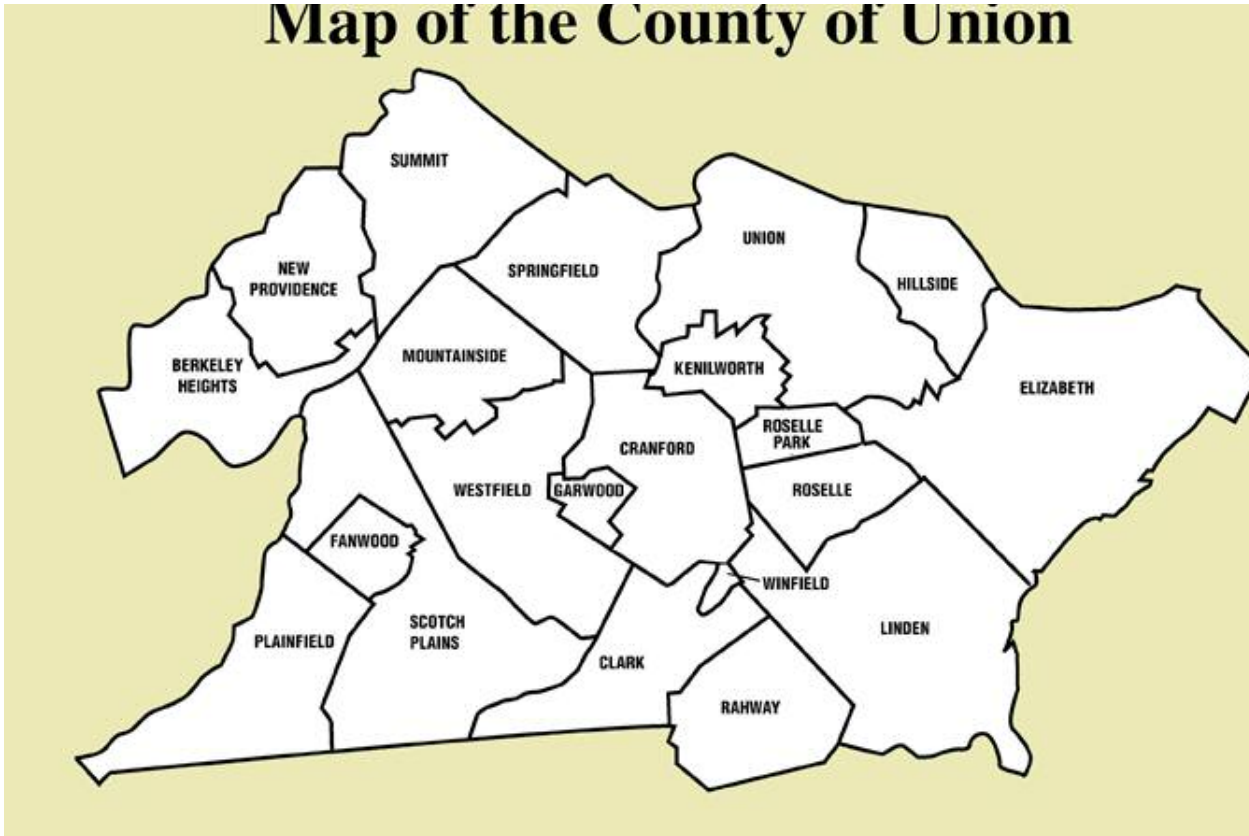

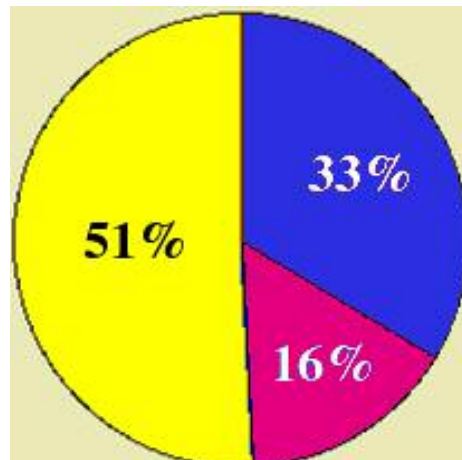

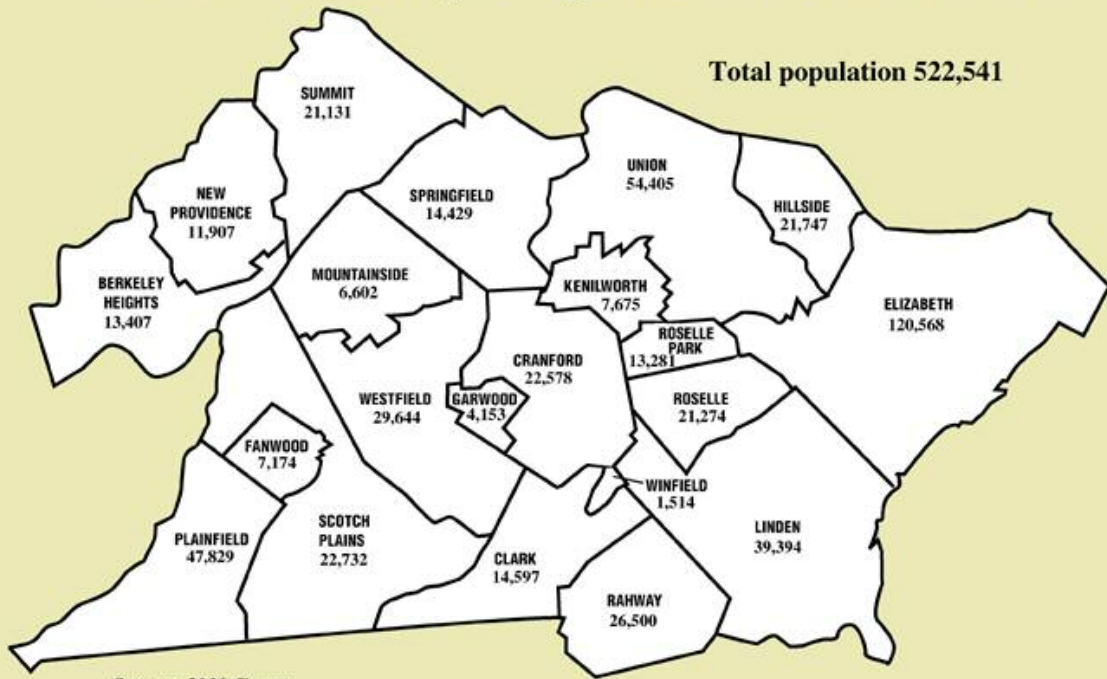

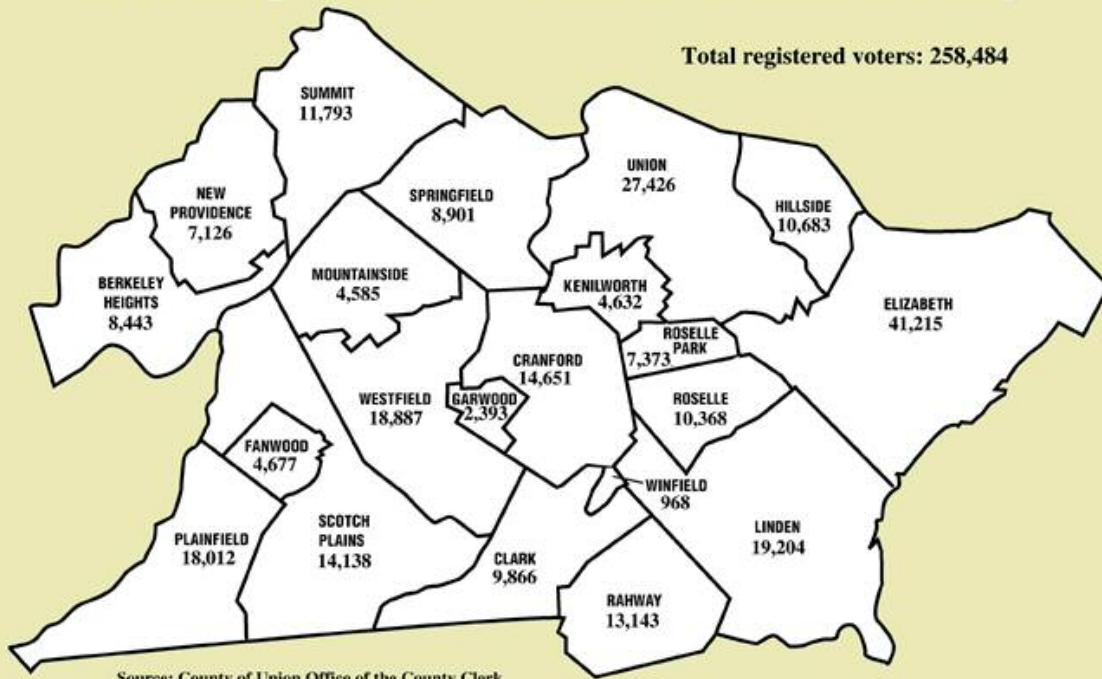

2003 Registered Voters in Union County



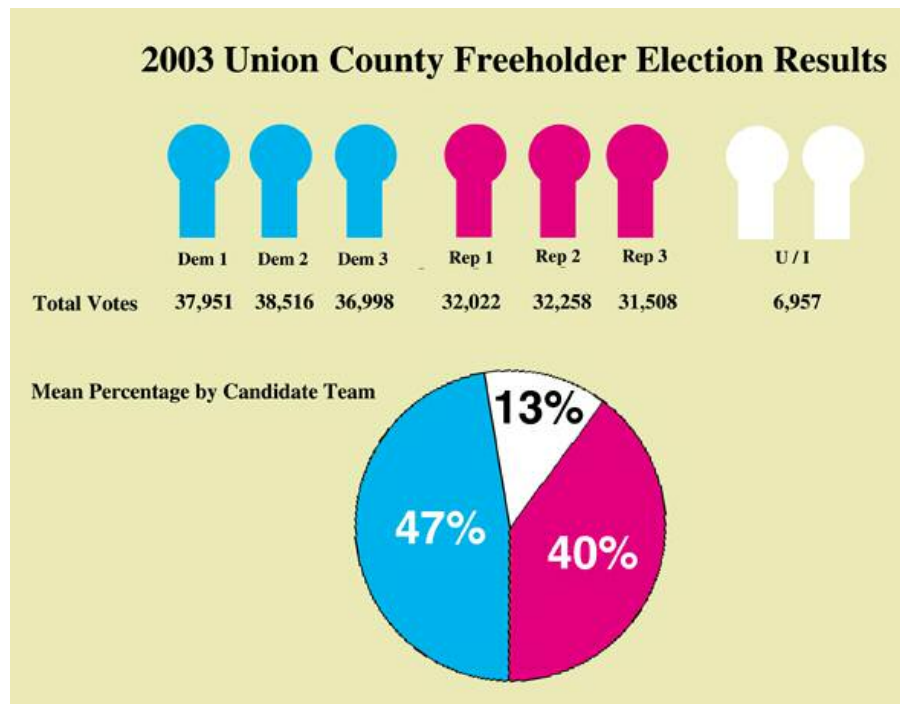

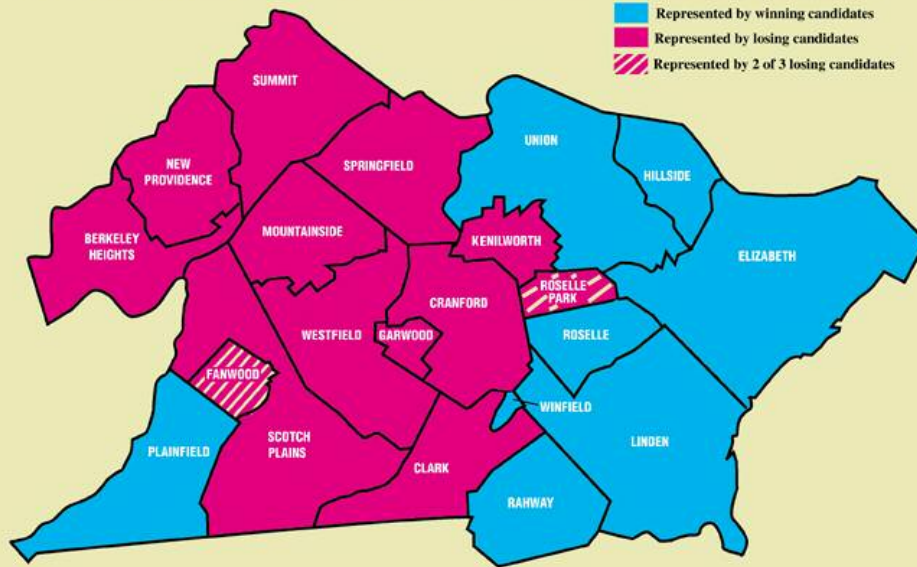

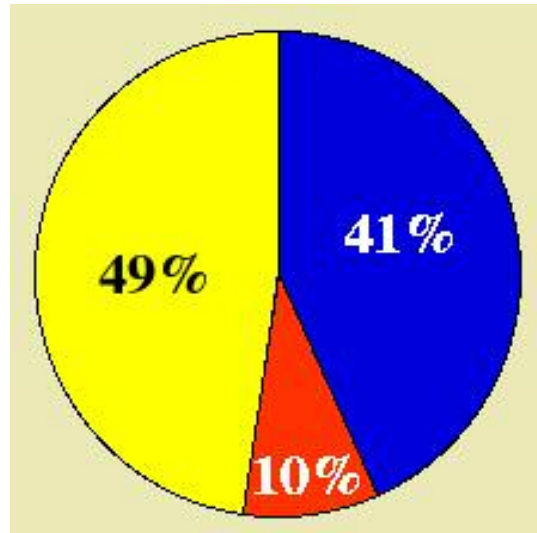
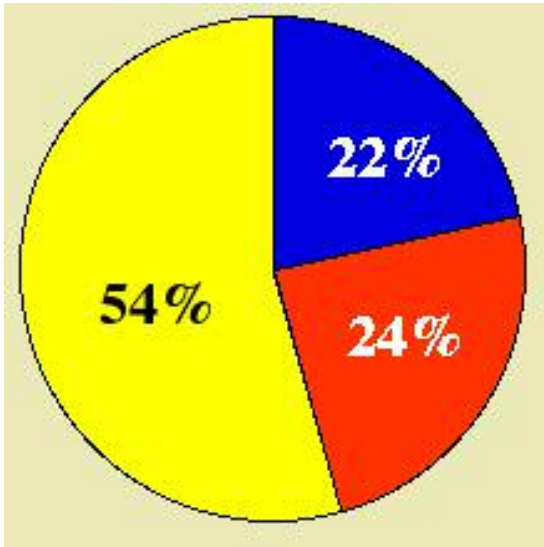
