I am once again happy to inform you about the many exciting Summer activities sponsored by our Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders in our parks this year, which concludes with MusicFest '08 on September 5th and 6th.

From free movies in our parks to concerts, festivals and our regular activities, our Union County parks system has it all. Following the exciting opening of the concert season with our annual Rhythm and Blues by the Brook (which featured Isaac Hayes!) in Plainfield earlier this month, we began the Summer Arts Festival concerts on July 2nd with the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra. All concerts are held on Wednesdays at 7:30 p.m. at Echo Lake Park in Mountainside throughout July and August.

On June 24th, we are also began another season of our popular Family Flix movies in our parks system with a showing of the movie, *Hook*, at Warinanco Park in Elizabeth. We will be showing a total of six movies throughout three County parks, concluding in August. The first four movies begin at 9 p.m., and the latter two at 8:45 p.m.

For our children, we are presenting the ever-popular Kids Kingdom Traveling Jubilee, which offers entertainment, games rides, and crafts. The show makes its next stop on July 13th at the Watchung Reservation.

And finally, this year, we are presenting, in conjunction with main sponsor, Overlook Hospital, MusicFest '08 on two consecutive days—Friday, September, 5th (4-10 p.m.) and that Saturday (Sept. 6th, 10 a.m.-10 p.m.) at Nomahegan Park in Cranford.

Last year, MusicFest drew more than 50,000 attendees. This year's two-day event will once again feature expanded opportunities for musical entertainment as an additional stage has been added, family fun with Kids Kingdom in a new larger location, with new vendors, plus a walkathon and newly-added 5k race for charity. The Shane Walsh Field area will also include a stage for family acts, a petting zoo for children, arts and crafts, and a laser tag field for children. The John Lennon Educational Tour Bus, a mobile audio recording and educational vehicle that teaches students to play music, write songs and more, will be on hand both days.

The Rock on! Walkathon and 5k Rock N' Run (on a certified USATF course) will precede the festival on Saturday, September 6th. The run start is 9 a.m. and the walk start is 9:15 a.m. Registration begins at 7:30 a.m.

The run and walk will benefit the Love Hope Strength Foundation (www.lovehopestrength.org) and The Valerie Fund (www.thevaleriefund.org).

This year, we will raise money to support children with cancer and blood disorders in NJ and global cancer centers.

Last year, many of you joined me in the first Rock On! Walkathon and together we raised more than \$75,000 for both the Love Hope Strength Foundation and stem cell research.
