**Describe the project (purpose and anticipated outcome):**

It is well known that the Jersey City-Newark UASI region is one of the most densely populated areas in the entire country. Some of the country's most critical infrastructure (CI) sites and key resources (KR) are located within this important region, with several sites having been confirmed targets of international terrorists.

This project will provide for the procurement of nine portable surveillance platforms that can be easily deployed at any of the CI/KR sites located in the region.

**PURPOSE:** To reduce the vulnerability and the risk of a terrorist attack at critical infrastructure sites throughout the UASI counties by providing security equipment to deter, delay and detect potential terrorist activity.

**ANTICIPATED OUTCOME:** The use of the equipment specified in this document assists various police agencies and their first responder partners in enhancing security protective measures at critical locations throughout the UASI region and serves to enhance security for the community as a whole.

**How is this project terrorism related?:**

This project provides for the acquisition and deployment of security equipment that can assist local law enforcement agencies in protecting Department of Homeland Security (DHS)/state designated CI/KR from possible terrorist attack.
