


In accordance with our last meeting, the following is our proposal to renovate your existing Marquee sign.

Each item of the renovation has been estimated separately so that you can choose which parts or parts of the work you deem most important this year.

1) Sign Renovation:

Takedown (2) existing lexan sign face panels and replace with new. Sign panel sizes approximately 6' x 12' x 3/16". New panels to be fabricated with opaque black vinyl copy to match existing. All new black vinyl rails to be supplied to allow for proper mounting of changeable letters.

New black aluminum moldings to be fabricated and installed for entire face surround.

Existing changeable letters to be re-utilized.

Cost: \$4200.00

2) Flat Cut Letters:

Fabricate and install new flat cut aluminum letters with copy to read "Performing". Lettering to be 3/4" thick plexiglass and painted as per customers request. Letters to be fastened to existing front Marquee with pin mounts.
