

Commissioners of a shared services committee were paid \$30,000 collectively and there is no evidence that this committee performed any work, or if they ever met

In 1999 the County of Union passed a resolution which established an Ad Hoc Committee to be known as the Union County Shared Services Committee. The Committee was composed of seven (7) members that were supposed to serve a term of two (2) years which term may be extended in order to complete any pending report. They were compensated \$3,000.00 per annum. The resolution then goes on to list 9 tasks the committee was charged with.

An Open Public Records Act request seeking the following documents was returned that no documents existed: Meeting minutes and all reports, recommendations and correspondence of the Shared Services Advisory Board since its inception to present.

The only documents the county released were those that showed what the commissioners were compensated. All seven were connected to the Union County Democratic Committee with 4 of the seven being elected municipal council members at the time.
